June is the Month of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

The Sacred Heart of Jesus represents the love and compassion that Jesus has for humanity. The heart is a symbol of love and devotion, representing the very essence of Jesus Christ. The feast of the Sacred Heart is celebrated on the Friday after the octave of Corpus Christi, which falls on the third Sunday after Pentecost. This year, the Solemnity of Most Sacred Heart of Jesus is celebrated Friday, June 27. Though it is a solemnity, it is not a holy day of obligation. Although devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus goes back many centuries, it was not celebrated universally in the Church until 1856 when Pope Pius IX made it a solemnity.

Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus grew after the apparitions of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque, which included instructions on a novena and promises from Jesus for those who honor his heart.

Jesus Himself started the First Friday devotion. In the last of twelve Sacred Heart Promises, He said, "I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will

grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment."

During the month of June, Catholics are encouraged to deepen their devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

through prayer, reflection, and acts of charity. One popular devotional practice is the daily recitation of the Litany of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. This litany is a prayer of intercession that asks for the mercy, love, and protection of Jesus.

In addition to prayer, Catholics may also participate in the Enthronement of the Sacred Heart. This practice involves placing an image of the Sacred Heart in a prominent place in the home, such as the living room or bedroom. The Enthronement is a way of inviting Jesus into the home and acknowledging His role as the head of the family.

III. O my Jesus, you have said: 'Truly I say to you, heaven and earth will pass away but my words will not pass away.' Encouraged by your infallible words I now ask for the grace of... . (here name your request) Our Father... . Hail Mary... . Glory Be to the Father...

Sacred Heart of Jesus, I place all my trust in you.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, for whom it is impossible not to have compassion on the afflicted, have pity on us miserable sinners and grant us the grace which we ask of you, through the Sorrowful and Immaculate Heart of Mary, your tender Mother and ours.

Say the Hail, Holy Queen and add: St. Joseph, foster father of Jesus, pray for us.

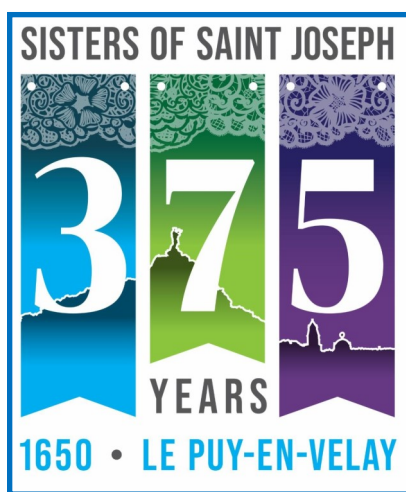

Most Holy Trinity Sunday

The Catechism of the Catholic Church teaches...

What is Most Holy Trinity Sunday?

The Catholic Church celebrates this unfathomable mystery each year on the Sunday following Pentecost. The mystery of the Most Holy Trinity is the central mystery of Christian faith and life. It is the mystery of God in Himself. It is therefore the source of all the other mysteries of faith.

What does it mean for the Trinity to be a mystery?

The objects of the Christian Faith, such as the Trinity, are above-created natures. As supernatural realities, they cannot be discovered by reason or the senses but must be revealed by God, who alone fully knows and understands them. This makes the Trinity a mystery.

What does it mean for God to be a "Trinity"?

The Trinity is One. We do not confess three Gods, but one God in three persons, the "consubstantial Trinity." The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire: "The Father is that which the Son is, the Son that which the Father is, the Father and the Son that which the Holy Spirit is, i.e. by nature one God."

The divine persons are really distinct from one another. "God is one but not solitary." "Father", "Son", "Holy Spirit" are not simply names designating modalities of the divine being, for they are really distinct from one another: "He is not the Father who is the Son, nor is the Son he who is the Father, nor is the Holy Spirit he who is the Father or the Son." They are distinct from one another in their relations of origin: "It is the Father who generates, the Son who is begotten, and the Holy Spirit who proceeds." The divine Unity is Triune.

Who are the three Divine Persons?

God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit are the Three Divine Persons of the Blessed Trinity.

Who is the First Person of the Trinity?

God the Father is the First Person of the Blessed Trinity. This means He is the Source or Principle of what is called the "processions" of the other two Persons.

Who is the Second Person of the Trinity?

The Son is the Second Person of the Blessed Trinity. He processes from the Father as His Divine Word from all eternity.

Who is the Third Person of the Trinity?

The Holy Spirit is the Third Person of the Blessed Trinity. He processes from the Father and the Son as their Spirit, the Spirit of Love.

It was the sending of the Spirit that we celebrated last week in the feast of Pentecost and it is the unity of Father, Son and Spirit that we celebrate this week in Most Holy Trinity Sunday.



All are Welcome – outside procession on Corpus Christi

Sunday, June 22nd, is the Feast of Corpus Christi, the day we celebrate that Jesus gave us himself: body, blood, soul and divinity, in Holy Communion. He feeds us with himself because he knows we need him to become like him.

Following the 12:30pm Mass, ALL are welcome to join Fr. Dennis and Fr. Charles as they process around the church property with the Blessed Sacrament, stopping at three different locations offering prayers and readings in honor of the Holy Eucharist. We will process with the Blessed Sacrament under a beautiful canopy, accompanied by 6 tiki torches, 14 decorative umbrellas from India made for procession, our first communion children, the deacons, altar servers and more. There will also be recorded music for us to sing along with in procession as we honor the Lord.

The whole procession will be approximately 35 – 40 minutes but it will conclude back in the church with benediction. For those who cannot process, they are welcome to remain in the church for the final benediction.

Let us receive Holy Communion on June 22nd with profound gratitude and join the procession after the 12:30 Mass with joy over the love God has for us.
